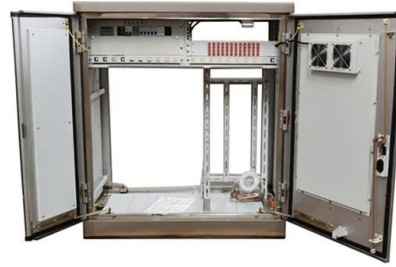

Non-renewable energy sources

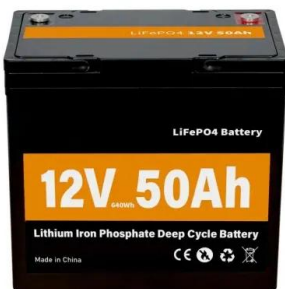

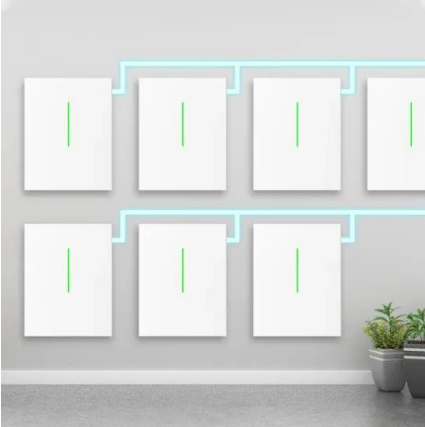
