

Brake system power bleeder pump 2003 jeep grand cherokee





Overview

You can access the bleeder screws on each wheel without removing the wheels and raising the car. However, if you feel like you need more room, loosen the lug nuts on all four wheels, raise the car, secure all four corners on jack stands and remove the wheels.

Locate the bleeder screw on the back of the brake caliper. You will have one on each caliper. When bleeding brakes, it goes right-rear, left-rear.

After you've finished bleeding all four calipers around your vehicle, top off the master cylinder with brake fluid and go for a careful test drive. Continue checking the brake fluid level for the next few days and top off as necessary.

How To Bleed Jeep Cherokee Rear Brakes , My Jeep Car

Have your helper pump the brake pedal a few times and then hold it down while you turn on the power bleeder. Bleed the brakes until you see only clear fluid coming out of the bleeder valve. Once you have finished bleeding the brakes, make sure to close the bleeder valve and remove the clear tubing.

How To Bleed Your Brakes On A Jeep Grand Cherokee

In most cases, the brake fluid can be bled into the brake system by using either a power or vacuum bleeder or having someone else do it while you keep the key off. You should also avoid letting the pedal completely travel ...

If you go the 2 person route use a small hose off the bleeder in to a can or jar of brake fluid so you dont suck air back into the system. And pumping the brakes several times will break the air in the system into small bubbles, making it harder to get out.

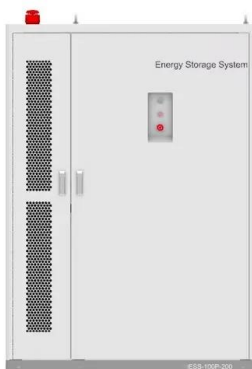

3. If a brake line is deiconnected at a fitting located between the master cylinder and any of the brakes, that part of the system served by the disconnected line must be bled. 4. Remove any residual vacuum from the brake power booster by applying the brake 5.

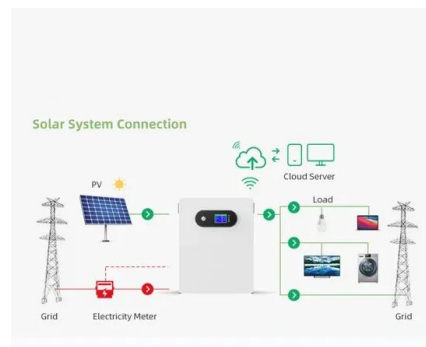

How To Bleed Brakes

Step 3: Open the bleeder valve on the wheel cylinder (drum brakes) or brake caliper (rotor brakes) to move the fluid through the lines. Close the valve before the brake pedal is release. Step 4: Pump the pedal up and hold as step 2 described, and repeat step 3.
