

# **Can the door of the locker be higher than the door of the room**





## Overview

---

The entities that inhabit The Rooms are particularly enigmatic. Similar to the entities in the Hotel, most of them only serve to hinder the player's progress. There are currently five.

How high should a locker be above the floor?

Storage spaces such as shelves, hooks, coat rods and lockers should be located at between 15 and 48 inches above the floor. If lockers are provided, five percent must meet ADA specifications. The locking mechanism should be no higher than 48 inches above the floor.

How big should a locker room be?

In an open facility like a locker room there must be a minimum clear floor space of 30 inches by 48 inches that allows for either forward or parallel approach of lockers by a person using a wheelchair. An accessible dressing room with a sliding or swing door requires a 180 degree turning circle inside.

How many locker rooms are ADA compliant?

In accordance with Section 225.2 of the 2010 ADA Standard, for locker rooms with 1 to 200 lockers, at least five percent but no fewer than one must be accessible, and in facilities with more than 201 lockers, ten lockers plus two percent of the total number of units over two hundred must be accessible. So what does "accessible" mean?

Where should lockers be placed?

Lockers should be placed in an area that allows full door swing and wheelchair turning ability. Lockers shall be placed in a location at least 24" away from any wall or other obstacle and have a minimum clear floor space of 30" x 48" with



a 10" minimum for door swing.

Should I camp at lockers when opening a new door?

I highly recommend camping at lockers when opening new doors. There are several room types with lockers that are next to or very close to the door. In these types of rooms with lockers, I always open the door and immediately backtrack towards the nearest locker. If I do not hear a sound cue, I know that I can continue.

How far away should a locker be from a wall?

Lockers shall be placed in a location at least 24" away from any wall or other obstacle and have a minimum clear floor space of 30" x 48" with a 10" minimum for door swing. The area in front of the locker must be clear within a 60" diameter turning circle to allow for unobstructed access. See Figure 3.

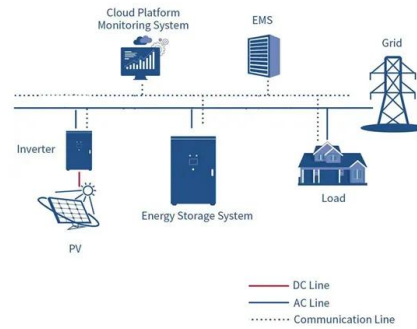
