

Community solar panel support





Overview

The new £10million Community Energy Fund (CEF) will initially be based upon the same criteria as the previous Rural Community Energy Fund, although will be opened up to applicants from urban areas. The aim of the fund is to help kickstart projects including small-scale wind farms and rooftop solar partnerships, as well.

How does BSc support community energy projects?

Finance and support for community energy. Community Energy Fund: draws on a credit facility from Big Society Capital (social impact fund), which can be augmented through donations. Bridge Finance: £30 million revolving loan facility from BSC to support large-scale community energy projects.

How can I Fund Wedmore First School's solar panels?

Start by contacting your local council to see if they offer any local grant funding schemes for your proposed measures. If your area has a Local Action Group or a Rural Community Council, they may also have a small grants scheme.

This includes (but is not limited to), solar panels, wind farms, hydro power, rural heat networks, electric vehicle charging points, car clubs and fuel poverty alleviation schemes.

Can a community-owned rooftop solar system be ethically sourced?

Efforts to do this have been made by councils like Kensington & Chelsea and Fenland District Council in its Fenland for Business scheme. The Big Solar Co-op is an excellent example of how it is possible to implement community-owned and ethically sourced rooftop solar at the national scale.

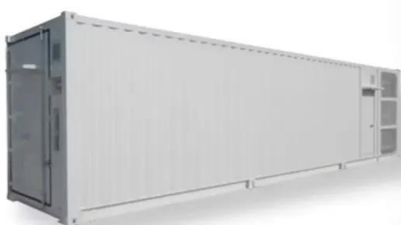

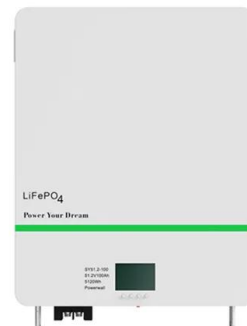

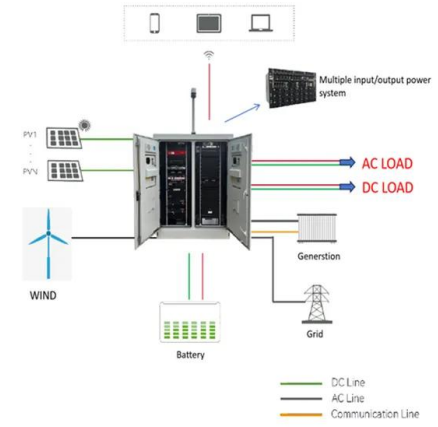
