Overview

Does CoServ buy back solar energy?

CoServ buys back solar energy at the full-retail rate of electricity, up to a customer's monthly electric usage. Any solar energy produced that exceeds a home's usage is sent to CoServ for free. There is a \$20 minimum bill for CoServ solar customers that cannot be offset by solar energy.

When does CoServ install metering equipment?

CoServ installs metering equipment within 10 days of being notified of completion of the solar installation. The solar installer will notify CoServ once the installation is complete. A single, bi-directional meter that runs forward and backward is used to measure both energy consumption and solar energy production.

How does CoServ work in Texas?

In Texas, unlike most areas, CoServ has a regulated service territory, meaning CoServ's customers cannot choose what company they purchase electricity from. Instead, they must use one of CoServ's rate options. Homeowners who install solar panels on their roof can participate in CoServ's net metering program.

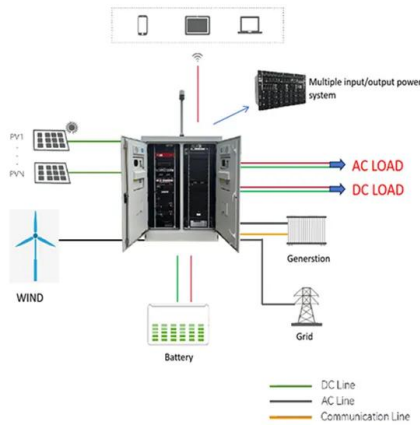

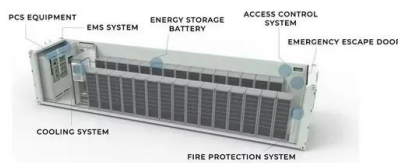

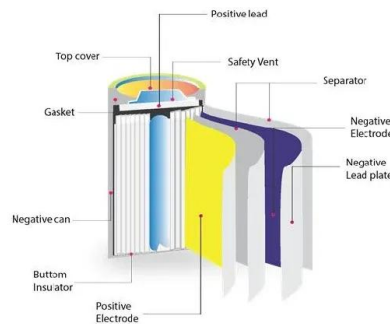
