How many planets are in our Solar System?

It is the only known planet in the solar system to possess an atmosphere containing free oxygen, oceans of liquid water on its surface, and life. Its radius is about 3,958.8 miles (6,371.00 km). Earth is definitely the place! Our moon is the only other place in the solar system that that humans have



visited.

Which planets have a moon?

Moons orbit planets. Right now, Jupiter has the most named moons—50. Mercury and Venus don't have any moons. Earth has one. It is the brightest object in our night sky. The Sun, of course, is the brightest object in our daytime sky. It lights up the moon, planets, comets, and asteroids.

The picture is a montage assembled from four different April 1999 telescope pointings with Hubble's Wide Field Planetary Camera 2, which used six different colour filters. The picture is dominated by a large, approximately circular feature, which is part of the Keyhole Nebula, named in the 19th century by Sir John Herschel.

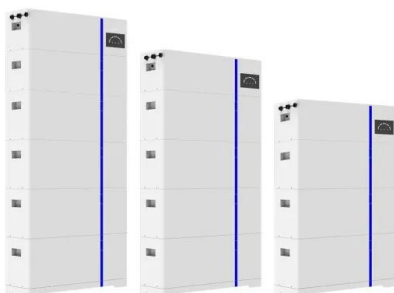
