

Does snow slide off solar panels

When the angle is correct, the snow will melt a little and then slide right off. Sweeping the snow off your solar panels is an option.

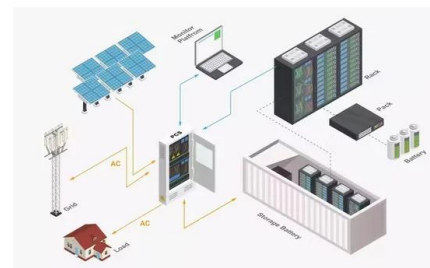

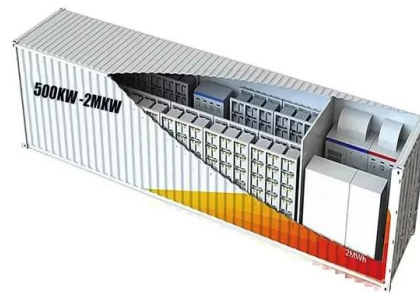

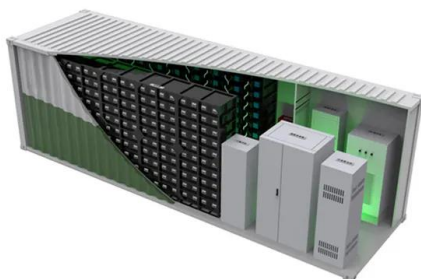
