Condenser microphones require power to work, on Focusrite interfaces when you press the '48V' button, phantom power (48V) is sent to the XLR microphone input for that input (or inputs). 48V Phantom power is not sent to any 1/4" jack inputs, these are used for line or instrument inputs.

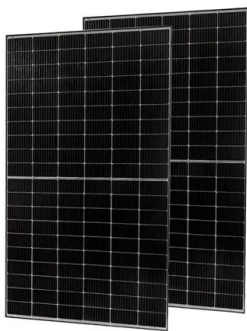

48v phantom power is for certain microphones that require power to boost the signal to standard "mic" level, namely large diaphragm condenser mics, though some others may use the power as well. Air is a selection that gives a bit of an EQ shelf starting around the 7k region, providing an additional "airiness" and mid-high end boost that simulates the Focusrite ISA preamps.



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
