

Don't photovoltaic panels need insulation





Overview

Are solar panels a legal requirement for new homes?

Even though installing solar panels on new builds is a great way to set new homes up with renewable energy from day one, it's not yet a legal requirement. One common problem is that developers don't use all the available roof space, resulting in a less effective solar panel system.

Can solar panels be installed on buildings?

To help accelerate that shift, the European Commission has proposed large-scale installation of solar panels – also called photovoltaic (PV) panels – on the roofs of buildings, starting in 2027. Within the built environment solar power is by far the most commonly used renewable energy source.

Can you put solar panels on a roof?

Ground-mounted systems are another alternative to fitting solar panels on your roof. Some state-of-the-art systems can rotate to follow the sun and maximise the amount of electricity they produce. This can be a good option if your roof isn't a suitable place to put a solar panel system. However, they may need foundations and can also be pricey.

Can a UK roof support solar panels?

As long as your roof is pitched, has enough unshaded space, and doesn't contain spray foam insulation underneath, it should be suitable for solar panels. The large majority of UK roofs are more than capable of supporting solar panels for as long as you need them to.

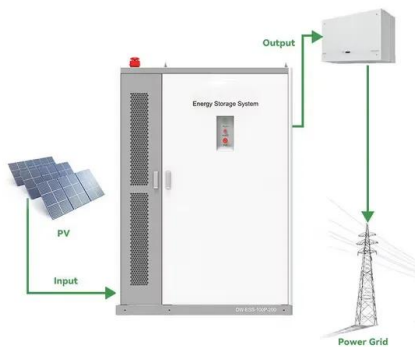

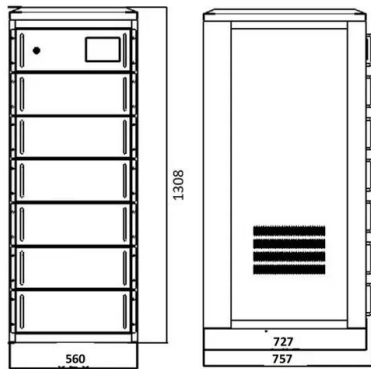

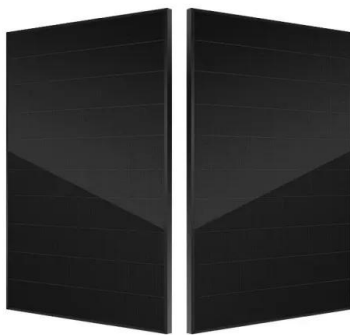
