Eversource itself does not offer any solar rebates or incentives, but there are incentives customers of Eversource can take advantage of. First is the federal solar tax credit, which is equal to 30% of the cost of installing a solar panel system. You can get that money back on your taxes the year after installation.

In New Hampshire, you can choose whether you want to own your solar panels through a cash purchase or solar loan, or you can choose “third party solar,” (or in other words, a solar lease) where a solar company installs a system on your roof and charges you a monthly.

Does Eversource bank excess solar energy?

For customers in CT, Eversource banks excess solar energy you send to the grid, and applies any extra kilowatt-hour (kWh) credits for you to use in the following month (s).



How does Eversource work?

Eversource is required by state law to allow homeowners to connect solar panels to their homes and to the grid. The company tracks the solar energy you produce and the grid power you consume, then gives you credit if that production exceeds consumption through a process called net metering. Eversource is involved in the process of enabling homeowners to use solar energy and manage their energy consumption.

Does Eversource offer other solar incentives?

Eversource does not offer other solar incentives directly to customers. However, there is a federal tax credit for solar, as well as some state incentives: Interconnection is the process of physically connecting your solar panels (or other renewable energy source) to Eversource's electric power system.

Is going solar with Eversource a good deal?

Going solar with Eversource as your utility company is very likely a good deal. Eversource is legally obligated to buy renewable energy, and the solar power you can make on your roof is probably enough to power your home and save you a ton of money in the process.

What is Eversource net metering?

Eversource net metering is a renewable rate program available to customers using their own renewable energy source to generate electricity. The program measures the difference between electricity delivered by Eversource to a customer and the amount of renewable energy that the customer generates and feeds back into the grid.

Solar Project Timeline

Eversource will install new meters to measure how much energy your solar panels produce and how much energy you use from Eversource and send back to the grid. When the installation is complete, the contractor should test the equipment to confirm that it is operating properly and provide you instructions on how to operate and maintain your system.

If you are installing distributed generation (e.g., solar panels), or already have a generator, you may be eligible for net metering. Net Metering is the process of measuring the difference between electricity delivered by Eversource to the customer and electricity generated by the customer with a Class 1, Class 2 or Class 3 net metering facility and fed back to Eversource.
