Overview

Can you buy solar power in Peach State?

Residents of the Peach State who can't put solar on their own roof can still buy solar power. Community solar projects -- essentially large solar farms -- allow utility customers to subscribe to a piece of the output of the solar energy, and in return potentially receive lower electricity bills.

Does Georgia Power offer solar?

How much does community solar cost in Georgia?

Customers of Georgia Power can sign up directly for community solar output by enrolling online. It costs \$24.00 per 1 kilowatt block per month to sign up. The utility's website says, "You should expect that the Community Solar



charge to participate in the program may exceed any bill credits received from solar production."

Does Georgia have a solar incentive program?

Unlike many states that give residents money or tax credits to offset the cost of solar, Georgia does not have any statewide incentive programs of this type. It's best to look to programs run by local communities or utility companies for financial help.

Simple Solar FAQs

Georgia Power's Simple Solar program uses energy from renewable generation that meets the criteria approved by the Georgia Public Service Commission. Additionally, Georgia Power's Simple Solar program purchases certified renewable energy credits (RECs) that meet specific environmental and consumer-protection standards.



Georgia Solar Incentives, Tax Credits & Rebates 2024

Georgia doesn't offer any state-specific battery incentives. However, all batteries larger than 3 kWh are eligible for the same 30% federal tax credit as solar panels. Batteries can make good financial sense as part of a home solar system in Georgia. The state's net

Ready to Install

Neither Georgia Power nor the State of Georgia currently offer any incentives or rebates for residential solar installations. However, there is a federal investment tax credit available for 30%. We would recommend speaking with an accountant or CPA to ensure you can take advantage of it when you file your taxes the next year.
