Check with [Earth 911.com](http://Earth911.com) to find a recycling location near you. Button-cell or coin batteries can be a potential swallowing hazard. Be certain to store them out of the reach of young children.

What is reuse & repurposing a lithium-ion battery?

Reuse and repurposing are two similar, environmentally friendly alternatives to recycling or disposal of a lithium-ion battery that no longer meets its user’s needs or is otherwise being discarded. Battery performance degrades over time, but used batteries can still provide useful energy storage for other



applications.

How do you store lithium ion batteries?

To prevent fires, tape battery terminals and/or place lithium-ion batteries in separate plastic bags. 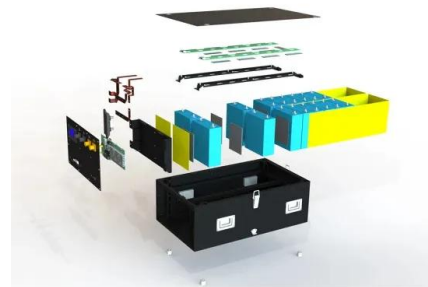

For lithium-ion batteries, place each individual battery in a separate clear plastic bag. For all other household batteries, use clear packing tape, electrical tape or duct tape across the ends of the batteries to prevent battery ends from touching one another or striking against metal surfaces, then place the batteries in a clear plastic bag for transport, disposal or recycling.
