

# **How long can flower plugs be kept in a locker**





## Overview

---

How long does it take to plant plugs out?

Place the trays on a clean bench, or on cardboard if you must put them on the ground. Transplant your plugs within one week of receipt. Plugs are ready to plant out upon arrival, assuming conditions are suited to the plant. If you cannot plant out your plugs out within one week, bump them up to 50 or 72 cell trays so they do not become rootbound.

Where should Plug plants be kept?

Plug plants should be kept on a sunny windowsill or in a greenhouse. The minimum temperature for them is 7 degrees Celsius. If you are planting hanging baskets or patio containers, your plugs can be planted straight into them, as long as they will be kept inside in the warm.

When should I unpack my plug plants?

When your plug plants arrive, unpack them as soon as possible. Our jumbo size plug plants should be potted into 9 or 10cm pots, using a good quality multipurpose compost. We recommend Jack's Magic compost for potting on, as it is very fine.

Are plugs ready to plant out?

Plugs are ready to plant out upon arrival, assuming conditions are suited to the plant. If you cannot plant out your plugs out within one week, bump them up to 50 or 72 cell trays so they do not become rootbound. Gro n' Sell does a fantastic job packing each and every tray of plugs they ship, with the goal of arrival in perfect shape.

How long do garden plugs last?

Standard plugs – also called medium plugs or simply plugs, they're 6-8cm from base to tip. They're on sale from April onwards and should be ready to go out after six to eight weeks Jumbo plugs – also called garden-ready plugs,



these are the largest, at 8-12cm from base to tip.

What is the minimum temperature for Plug plants?

Plug plants need to be kept at a minimum of 7 degrees Celsius. If you are planting hanging baskets or patio containers, your plugs can be planted straight into them, as long as they will be kept inside in the warm.

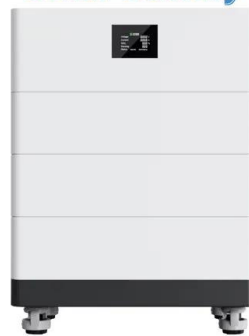

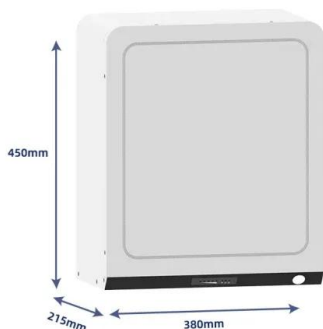

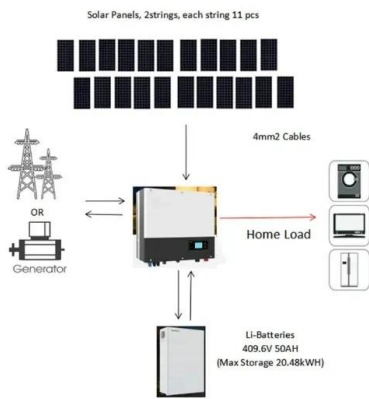
