

How to dispose rechargeable batteries





Overview

To dispose of rechargeable batteries safely, you can: Bring them to specialized battery recyclers, participating retailers that provide battery takeback services, or local household hazardous waste collection programs. Contact the manufacturer or your local household waste authority for other management options. Remove the battery from the device if possible. Store batteries in a cool, dry place such as a plastic container. If the batteries are physically damaged, store them in an insulated plastic bag to avoid any short-circuiting. Sort your batteries by type, especially if you're disposing of them in collection boxes or bags. Can a rechargeable battery be recycled?

For example, the Cobalt (Co) in Lithium Ion batteries can be used in magnetic alloy. Nickel (Ni) and Iron, from Nickel Metal Hydride and Nickel Cadmium batteries, can be used in stainless steel; the Cadmium (Cd) can be used to make new rechargeable batteries. It therefore makes good economic sense to recycle rechargeable batteries.

How do you dispose of a battery?

To take advantage of this service, residents must simply tape up their batteries' exposed terminals (so they don't short-circuit and start a fire), seal them in a plastic bag, and set them on top of their recycling bin on their regular pickup day.

Where can I recycle a used battery?

EPA recommendation: send used alkaline and zinc carbon batteries to battery recyclers or check with your local or state solid waste authority. These small, round batteries have historically contained silver, cadmium, mercury or other heavy metals as their main component. Today, the majority are made of lithium metal.

Can I put a damaged rechargeable battery in a collection box?

No. For safety precautions, we do not suggest the public to put damaged rechargeable batteries into the collection boxes. Otherwise, the whole lot of collected batteries might get contaminated. You can properly contain the damaged battery in a plastic bag appropriate for its size and weight, after seal up, disposed of at garbage bin.

What is a rechargeable battery?

The deposited batteries are collected on a periodic basis, sorted and treated preliminarily according to battery type, stored and exported for recycling. Rechargeable batteries contain materials of good value that can be recovered and re-used. For example, the Cobalt (Co) in Lithium Ion batteries can be used in magnetic alloy.

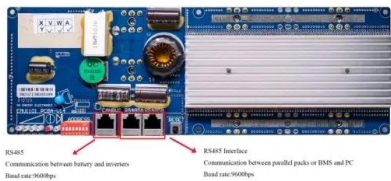
