

How to teach solar system to primary students





Overview

The following word bank contains words that may be covered when teaching about the solar s.

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How do you teach children about the Solar System?

Use an illustration, poster or drawing to introduce or review the planets. A link to a set of pictures of the planets in order is included under Additional Resources. Select a video on the sun, moon, stars and planets or share a solar system song to engage children and get them more interested in learning details about the solar system.

How can I help students learn about Solar System Science?

Use these free STEM projects, lessons, and activities to help students get hands-on exploring and learning about solar system science. The Earth, the Moon, the Sun, and space are concepts students identify early on.

How do students learn about planets?

In this lesson, students will begin to focus on specific planets within our solar system. They will select (or be allocated) a planet and research to find out more about it. They will present this information to the class and add it to a class solar system mural or poster. Students will activate their prior knowledge about planets.



What will students learn in a solar system class?

Students will be able to provide a brief explanation of what the solar system is, and what it contains, with a specific focus on the importance of the sun. Students will learn the order and relative size of the planets in our solar system by participating in the creation of a scaled model. 'Create your own solar system instructions' sheet.

How do pupils learn about the Solar System?

Our Solar System Working in groups, pupils will research different planets and objects in the Solar System and create a fact sheet to present to the class. Pupils will also make a two dimensional model of the eight planets. Draw the Sun on the far left of the board. To the right of the Sun draw a row.

How do I make a good lesson on the Solar System?

The most important thing when putting together a solid lesson or series of lessons on the solar system is to make sure the source references are reliable, accurate and trusted by fact checking and researching your sources before presenting learning materials on the solar system to children.

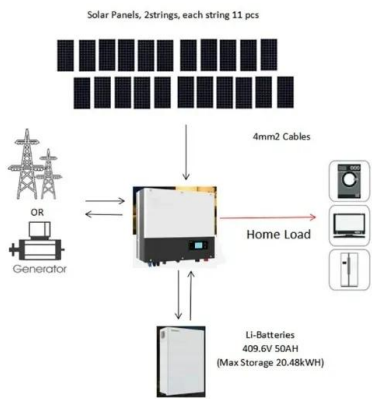

The Solar System is made up of the Sun and all of the smaller objects that move around it. Apart from the Sun, the largest members of the Solar System are the eight major planets. Nearest the Sun are four fairly small, rocky planets - Mercury, Venus, Earth and Mars.

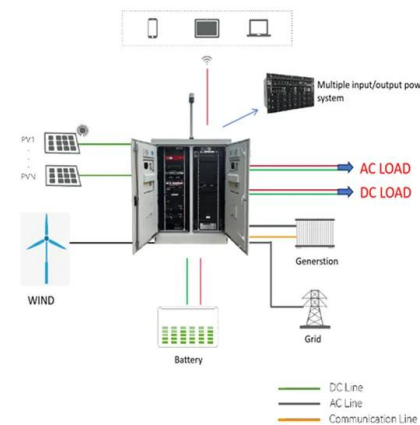
