

Is it profitable to install solar power on the roof





Overview

As solar panel systems on flat roofs are less efficient, they also won't save you as much on your electricity bills, so the trade-off may not be worth it. How many solar panels can be installed on a roof?

Your roof will need to be large enough to fit a suitable number of solar panels, as there's rarely much point putting just two or three panels up there. The average solar panel takes up 2m², and your installer should leave around 40cm on each side of the array, as well as 3cm between every panel.

Can solar panels be installed on a flat roof?

Do solar panels generate electricity on a south-facing roof?

Solar panels generate most electricity when they're on a south-facing roof that's sloped at 41°, and isn't shaded. It's one of the first things our surveyors look at when checking your home's right for solar. A good surveyor can talk you through how the panels' position on your roof will affect their performance.

Do you need a roof lease for solar panels?

If you rent or lease solar panels from a third party, you'll be required to sign a roof lease so that ownership of the solar panels doesn't pass to you once they're installed. This is because in English property law, unless a roof lease is in place, ownership of the panels would automatically pass to the property owner once installed.

How much does a solar panel weigh on a flat roof?

As mentioned earlier, solar panels on a flat roof need a heavy ballasted



mounting system to stay secure in high winds. And that ballast can make a solar panel up to five times heavier than a typical non-ballasted panel. A ballasted solar panel can weigh around 100kg, whereas a non-ballasted solar panel is only about 20kg.

Can a UK roof support solar panels?

As long as your roof is pitched, has enough unshaded space, and doesn't contain spray foam insulation underneath, it should be suitable for solar panels. The large majority of UK roofs are more than capable of supporting solar panels for as long as you need them to.

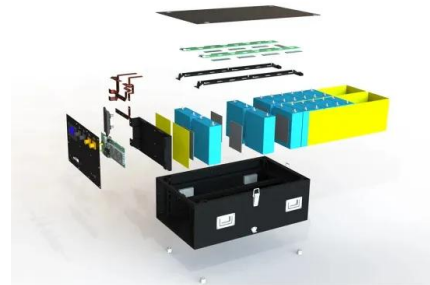

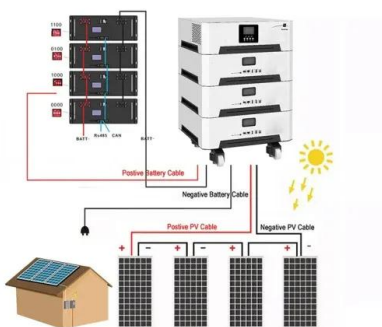
