Overview

As of 4 a.m., LES had restored high-voltage power lines that deliver electricity to thousands of customers, decreasing outages from 30,000 at the beginning of the storm to just under 7,000. Individual homes and businesses are currently being assessed and repaired. Restoration efforts will continue until the community is fully restored. How many customers were affected by the Lincoln Electric system outage?

LINCOLN, Neb. (KOLN) - Lincoln Electric System said they have restored 93% of outages overnight, with approximately 275 customers still impacted. LES said remaining outages have significant tree damage which will take more time to repair. At the height of the outage, more than 4,800 customers were affected.

What caused a power outage in Lincoln on July 31?

Rain, lightning and damaging winds caused widespread power outages throughout Lincoln and surrounding areas on the evening of July 31, resulting in more than 30,000 customers experiencing power outages at the situation's peak. LES crews worked overnight to assess damage quickly and safely restore as much service as possible.

How many Lincoln customers are without power during storms?

LINCOLN, Neb. (KLKN) - The Lincoln Electric System's website shows as many as 5,700 customers are without power during severe storms Saturday night. The largest affected area is near the intersection of Interstate 80 and Highway 34 in north Lincoln. Strong thunderstorms and gusting winds reaching nearly 70 miles per hour rolled through the area.

How many people were affected by a power outage?

At the height of the outage, more than 4,800 customers were affected. The power outages were mostly caused by trees falling on power lines due to severe weather. To report a power outage, go to the LES Website. Crews have restored 93% of outages overnight, with approximately 275 customers still



impacted.

What should I do if I have a streetlight problem in Lincoln?

If this is a life-threatening emergency, call 911 immediately. As a public power utility, along with maintaining the area's electric system, LES also helps the City of Lincoln maintain its streetlights. If you have noticed a streetlight problem, You also may call LES PowerLine, 24/7, to report your outage at 888.365.2412 (toll-free).

What caused a power outage?

The power outages were mostly caused by trees falling on power lines due to severe weather. To report a power outage, go to the LES Website. Crews have restored 93% of outages overnight, with approximately 275 customers still impacted. Remaining outages have significant tree damage, which may take more time to repair.

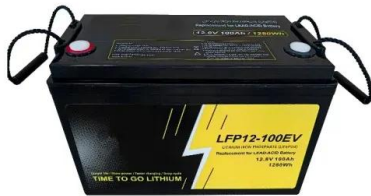
