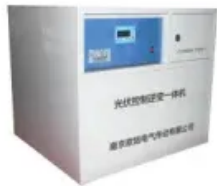

Overview

Can lithium ion batteries be recycled?

Lithium-ion batteries and devices containing these batteries should NOT go in household garbage or recycling bins. Lithium-ion batteries SHOULD be taken to separate recycling or household hazardous waste collection points. To prevent fires, tape battery terminals and/or place lithium-ion batteries in separate plastic bags.

How do you dispose of a lithium battery?

Check for the word “lithium” marked on the battery. Do not put button-cell, coin, or lithium single-use batteries in the trash or municipal recycling bins. Check with [Earth 911.com](http://Earth911.com) to find a recycling location near you. Button-cell or coin batteries can be a potential swallowing hazard. Be certain to store them out of the reach of young children.

What is the purpose of recycling lithium-ion batteries?

The purpose of recycling lithium-ion batteries is to avoid toxic electronic waste from clogging the landfills and to use the retrieved materials in the fabrication of new products. If you want to dispose of or recycle your old batteries, here are 4 steps you can take to safely recycle them.

Can swollen batteries be recycled?

Do not recycle swollen batteries. Many areas have electronic recycling centers that accept old electronic supplies for recycling. While you may prefer to recycle your waste, unfortunately swollen batteries are not safe to recycle as they cannot be reused. Handle swollen batteries with great care.

How to Dispose of or Recycle Old Batteries

Cylindrical (AA, AAA, C, D) and rectangular batteries may be alkaline, lithium (which is different from lithium-ion), zinc-carbon, nickel-cadmium (NiCd), or nickel-metal hydride (NiMH). Some button or coin batteries (like CR2032 used in Apple AirTags) are lithium, while others (like the common SR44/LR44 watch battery) use silver oxide or alkaline cells.

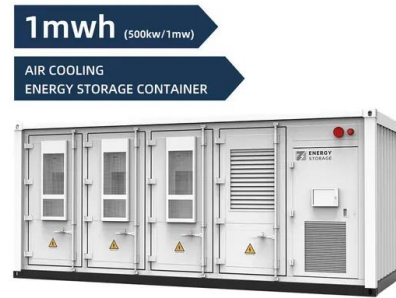
