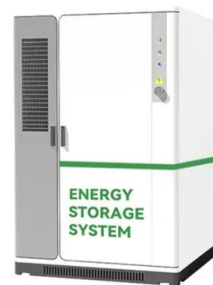

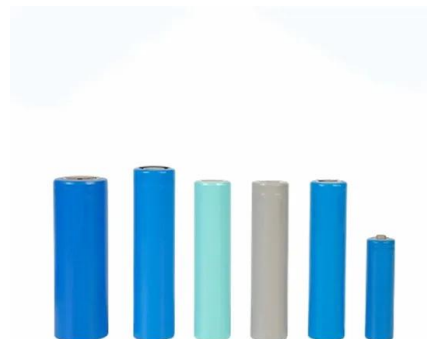


Planet Names By Letter
