Gases inside the pump chamber and septic tank are poisonous and the lack of oxygen can be fatal. Always keep your septic system well maintained; a well-maintained septic system is better able to withstand the stresses of a power outage. If you live in an area where power outages are common, take these steps to protect your septic system.

Can a septic tank pump be used during a power outage?

If you have a gravity-based septic system, you should be able to maintain normal water usage during a power outage. However, if your house also uses a well and requires an electrical pump to supply the house with water, then the septic tank pump might not function during a power outage. You can install back up power on your septic tank pump.

How long should a septic tank last before a power outage?

A septic tank, if sized appropriately, should last at least a day or so before it backs up during a power outage. If the power comes back on within this time, the pump should kick back on and move the wastewater out of the septic tank without any issues, assuming water usage was conserved during the outage.

How do I protect my septic system from a power outage?

Always keep your septic system well maintained; a well-maintained septic system is better able to withstand the stresses of a power outage. If you live in an area where power outages are common, take these steps to protect your septic system. Know and document all components of your septic system.

What happens if a septic system goes out?



Continue to reduce water use for several days. On-demand pumps begin the pump cycle whenever the wastewater volume reaches a pre-marked level in the septic tank, and the effluent is pumped into the drain field. During the power outage, effluent is not pumped to the drain field and may continue to collect.

Why does my septic tank alarm go off after a power outage?

An alarm may go off after a power outage when your septic tank pump is accidentally disconnected from its power source. Troubleshooting actions will include checking if there's a proper connection at the power source. A drain field is designed to treat wastewater through absorption.

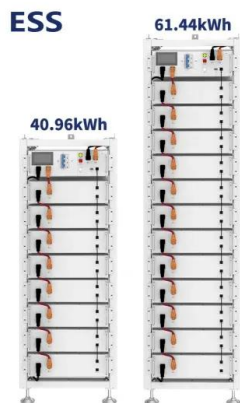

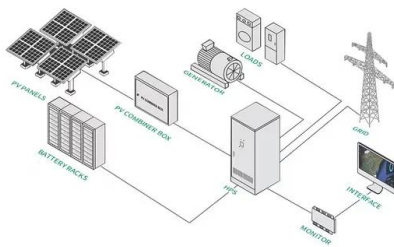

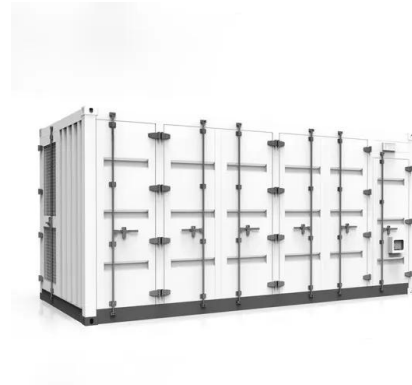
