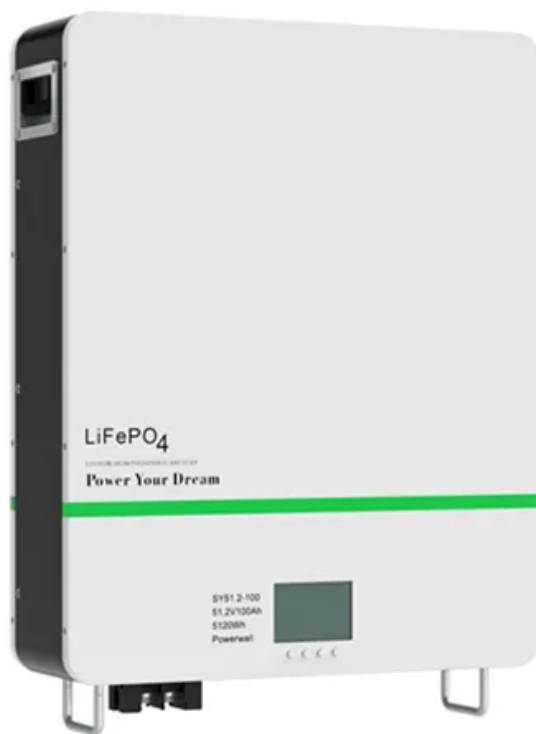


Sowing melons with photovoltaic panels will reap melons





Overview

Can we grow crops under solar panels instead of trees?

Traditionally, agricultural and agroforestry systems used multilayered plantings by, for example, cultivating shade-tolerant crops such as coffee under bananas. Now, with growing demand for clean energy but a paucity of empty land, researchers are exploring how to grow crops under raised solar panels (photovoltaics) instead of trees.

How do you grow melon vertically?

When growing melon plants vertically, lay a thick layer of garden compost or well-rotted manure over the root zone to hold in moisture and deter weeds. But leave a gap around the base of the stem, to avoid rotting. Alternatively, if the stems are trailing on the ground, consider covering the soil with biodegradable membrane.

How do you grow a MelOn in April?

Kick-start your melon mission in April by sowing two seeds in 9cm pots of compost and place inside either an electric propagator or on a sunny windowsill and keep at a temperature of 18-20°C. After a while, remove the weakest seedling, allowing the stronger of the two to grow on, until it has formed three to four true leaves.

How to choose a melon to grow in the UK?

Choose the Variety of Melon It is a very crucial step to choose a melon you want to grow from the wide variation of melons available. So, it is a great idea to grow both honeydew and muskmelon if you are planning to grow them in a greenhouse. And both of these variations of melons are suitable to be grown in the UK.

How do you support a melon plant?

Suitable supports include sturdy bamboo canes, netting, vertical strings or



trellis, which their tendrils can twine around. Melons can make large plants and the fruits can be heavy, so make sure the supports are strong and well anchored.

How to grow Melon in winter?

Do not forget to leave around 4 to 6 feet of space between the mounds so that melons have enough room to grow and flourish. In case you live in a place where winters are longer, then you can keep your plants indoors. And when the temperature is warmer again outside, you can shift the melon plants outdoors. 6. 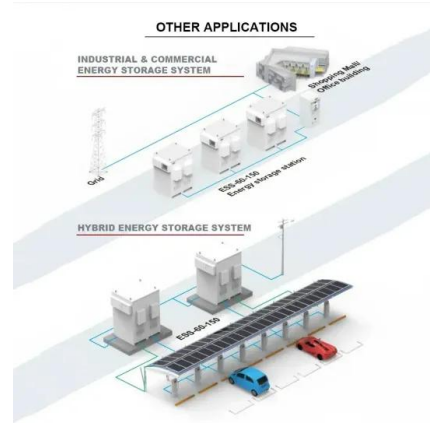
