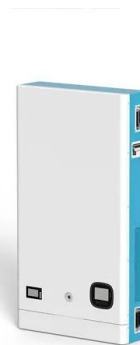

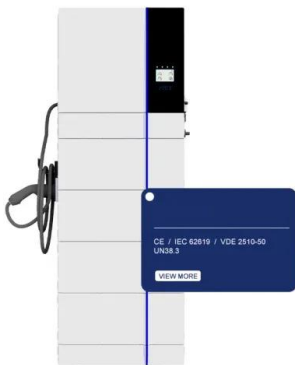

Franchise Tax Credit for Clean Energy Projects

Texas will begin issuing a franchise tax credit for up to three clean energy projects. The credit cannot be issued before the later of Sept. 1, 2018, or the expiration of an agreement under the Texas Economic Development Act, Chapter 313 regarding the clean energy project for which the credit is issued.

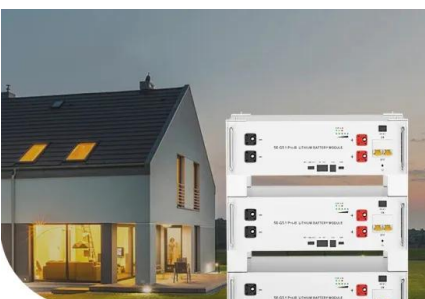

Texas solar incentives for 2023 and beyond

Under Texas's Renewable Energy Systems Property Tax Exemption law, homeowners who go solar are "exempt" from paying higher property taxes as a result of their PV installations. Adding solar panels can increase the value of your home (sometimes by a lot), and by taking advantage of this property exemption rule, you can save even more money.



Inflation Reduction Act Rebates and Tax Credits

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) allocated \$690 million to Texas for the State Energy Conservation Office (SECO) to implement and administer the programs. The HOMES and HEAR rebate programs are currently not available.

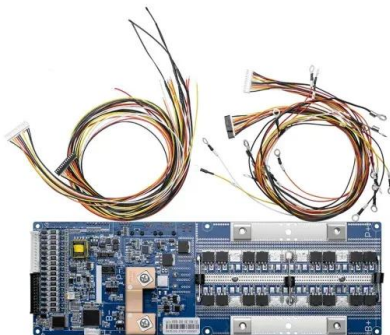
