Why are my solar lights not working at night?

Your solar lights aren't working at night probably due to depleted batteries, insufficient daily sunlight exposure, or the light sensor being affected by nearby artificial light sources. Where Is the Sensor on Solar Lights?

The sensor on solar lights is located on the solar panel or near the LED lights, designed to detect ambient light levels.

Can You restore solar lights that have stopped working?

No matter what kind of solar lights you own, they'll eventually start to get dim or stop working entirely. But can you do anything to revive them?

The answer is YES! To restore solar lights that have stopped working, you must first identify the source of the problem. Before you can identify the



solution, you must first figure out the cause.

How do you revive a solar light?

You can narrow it down by checking the batteries, the sensor, the location of the solar light, the solar panels on the light, and checking for any water seepage in the light itself. Once you've identified the cause, reviving your solar lights will become much more manageable.

What should I do if my solar panel is not working?

Clear any debris like leaves, dirt, or snow off the solar panels, which can easily block needed sunlight if left to accumulate. In northern climates, adjust the angle of the solar panel during winter months to account for fewer daylight hours and lower sun angles. 2. Inspect All Components

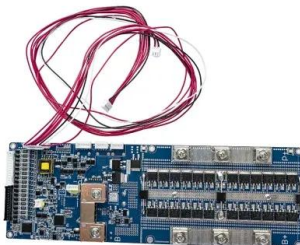

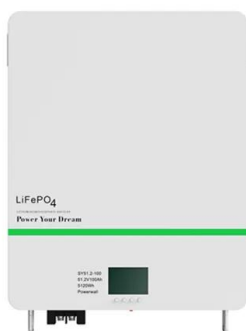

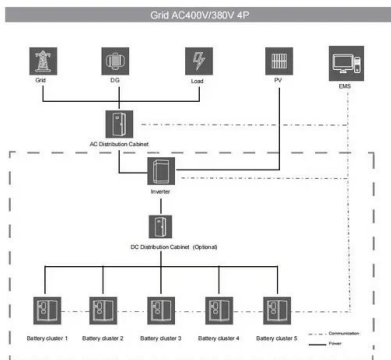
