

Why can't lithium batteries be checked





Overview

In 2024, it is mostly* common knowledge that lithium batteries should not be placed in checked luggage. This is because lithium batteries can catch fire if damaged or if battery terminals are short-circuited. Can you put a lithium battery in checked luggage?

Only installed lithium batteries in checked luggage are allowed. For example, laptop computers with a lithium-ion battery can go in checked luggage (but probably shouldn't as it may get damaged) provided the battery is correctly installed. It cannot be separated from the laptop. What if your carry on gets gate checked?

Can you carry a lithium battery on a plane?

Removed batteries must be carried in accordance with the provision for spare batteries. Checked Baggage equipped with lithium batteries are only allowed in checked baggage when containing lithium metal batteries with a lithium content not exceeding 0.3 grams, or lithium ion batteries with a Watt-hour rating not exceeding 2.7 Wh.

Can lithium batteries catch fire?

Lithium batteries, which power everyday devices, can catch fire if damaged or if battery terminals are short-circuited. Devices containing lithium metal batteries or lithium ion batteries, including – but not limited to – smartphones, tablets, cameras and laptops, should be kept in carry-on baggage.

Are batteries allowed in checked baggage?

Spare lithium metal and lithium ion/polymer batteries are prohibited in checked baggage—this includes external battery packs. Electronic cigarettes and vaporizers are also prohibited in checked baggage. “Checked baggage” includes bags checked at the gate or planeside. Q3. Are lithium batteries rechargeable?

Lithium batteries are not rechargeable whereas Lithium-ion batteries are rechargeable, so, they are not the same thing. However, the same rules apply to whether they are allowed in checked luggage or carry-on bags.

What is a lithium metal battery?

Lithium metal batteries are also known as non-rechargeable lithium and primary lithium. These spare batteries are most often used in cameras and other small personal electronic items. Consumer-sized spare lithium metal batteries (up to 2 grams of lithium per battery) may be carried.

You may carry drones without batteries in your checked baggage. The removed battery/batteries may be carried in your hand baggage, if they adhere to the regulations regarding spare batteries. Drone battery must not be charged during your flight.

Why can't you put lithium batteries in checked luggage? You can put lithium batteries in checked luggage, but there are restrictions. The reason is that lithium batteries are considered hazardous materials because they can catch fire or explode if they are mishandled.

Restricted and Prohibited Items

Small lithium battery-powered vehicles are not accepted in either checked baggage or carry-on baggage due to safety concerns associated to the lithium batteries that power them. Prohibited vehicles include: hoverboards, AirBoards, electric skateboards, airwheels, mini-Segways, balance



wheels, battery-assisted bikes and electric scooters.

All lithium batteries must be of a type that meets the requirements of the UN Manual of Tests and Criteria, Part III, subsection 38.3. Checked In Lithium-ion (polymer) 100Wh or less Batteries for mobile phones, handheld devices, laptops, tablets, small power

Pack It Right For Your Flight

Unknown to passengers, many household items and consumer products (eg. powerbanks and lithium batteries) are classified as dangerous goods. When such items are carried by passengers on board an aircraft in their checked or carry-on baggage, they can become a threat to the safety of passengers and crew.



Safety instructions for lithium batteries and dangerous goods

Lithium metal batteries:the lithium metal content must not exceed 2 g. Each person is limited to a maximum of 15 PED and limited to a maximum of 20 spare batteries. With operator approval,no more than 2 lithium ion batteries with a watt-hour rating exceeding 100 Wh but not exceeding 160 Wh are permitted in carry-on baggage only for each passenger.



Restricted and Prohibited Items , Baggage Information , Before ...

Only the following lithium batteries may be carried on board: Lithium-metal batteries with a lithium content of 2 g or less, and lithium-ion batteries with a watt-hour rating of 100 Wh or less. Take the necessary measures to prevent accidental activation of the heat producing component.

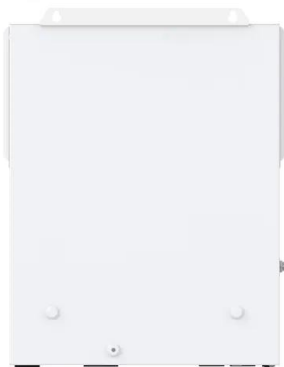
