Why is my electric bill so high with solar panels?

There are two reasons why your electric bill could be high with solar panels. First, your panels may not be producing enough electricity during the day to power your home and offset the grid electricity you are using at night. This is typically the case for systems with 1:1 net metering.

Do solar panels affect my electricity bill?

Your electricity bill with solar panels depends on a few factors, including the size of your system, electricity consumption, net metering policy, and the time of year. In many cases, solar systems can be designed to produce 100% bill offset so the homeowner is only paying for solar electricity or utility electricity – and not both.

Why is my electricity bill so high?

The average electricity bill in the United States varies from \$85 in Utah to over \$245 in Connecticut, so a \$500 monthly bill is very high. This is likely due to a combination of increased usage (EV charging, prolonged air conditioning, pool or hot tub heating, etc) and/or a significant electricity rate hike by your utility.

Do I still have an electric bill after installing solar panels?

Yes, you'll still have an electric bill before and after your solar panels are installed and producing clean energy. However, the balance due on your monthly bills will be much lower – or even negative – because your solar production replaces and offsets the cost of buying grid electricity from your utility.

Does a grid-tied solar system reduce your electric bill?

Can a solar system reduce your electricity bill?

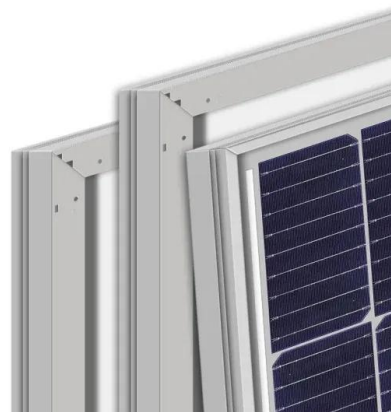

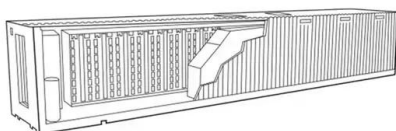
